HORIZON ADDS SERVICE TO LOS ANGELES AND SEATTLE

RENO, NV – More flights are on the horizon at the Reno-Tahoe International Airport when Alaska/Horizon Air begins three additional flights this June.

Beginning June 6, Horizon Air will offer an additional Los Angeles flight and two more flights to Seattle. This will bring the total number of Horizon Air flights to nine; four to Los Angeles, Reno-Tahoe International Airport's third largest market and five to the Emerald City, Seattle. All flights will operate with a 76 passenger Q-400 aircraft.

The announcement is the latest in a series of air service accomplishments at RNO. Over the past six months, Reno-Tahoe International has announced 13 additional flights while other airports across the country are still struggling to regain service lost through the challenging economy.

"The addition of flights on Horizon Air is a direct result of numerous meetings between the airport and Horizon to bring this new service to our region," Krys Bart, President/CEO of Reno-Tahoe International Airport, said. "The airport has worked hard for this service and any new flights we can announce is great news for our community."

- Non-stop daily service to Denver on Southwest Airlines; 737 aircraft with 136 seats. Same plane, direct service goes on to Boston. Service began January 10, 2010.
- Daily non-stops to Phoenix on Southwest Airlines; 737 aircraft with 136 seats; began January 10, 2010.

- Non-stop daily service to Dallas on American Airlines, 757 aircraft with 188 seats; began February 11, 2010.
- Daily non-stops to Boise on Southwest Airlines; 737 aircraft with 136 seats, will begin March 15, 2010.
- Non-stop daily to Portland on Southwest Airlines, 737 aircraft with 137 seats, will begin in May 2010.

Flights added on a seasonal basis this winter:

- Non-stop daily service to Mammoth on Horizon Air; Q-400 aircraft with 76 seats, began December 17, 2009 and will end in April of 2010.
- One additional non-stop to Los Angeles on United Airlines began December 18, 2009 will end in March 2010; Regional Jet with 50 seats.
- One additional non-stop to Phoenix on US Airways began December 18, 2009 ended January 3, 2010; A319 aircraft with 124 seats.
- One non-stop to Atlanta on Delta Air Lines began December 19, 2009 ended January 3, 2010; 757 aircraft with 183 seats.
- One additional non-stop to Denver on United Airlines effective January 5, 2010, typically offered through March, Regional Jet aircraft with 50 seats.
