New Regional Airline to Begin Service between Reno and Carlsbad, California

RENO, Nev. – Travelers will soon have another option flying to southern California from Reno-Tahoe International Airport just in time for the busy holiday season. California Pacific Airlines, a start-up air carrier focusing on west coast routes, will begin service from Reno (RNO) to Carlsbad McClellan-Palomar Airport (CLD) on November 2, 2018.

A new destination never before served by RNO, the non-stop Carlsbad flights will operate four times a week on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays on a 50-seat Embraer ERJ 145 aircraft. Scheduled times are as follows:

RNO – CLD

12:30 p.m. departure

Arrives in Carlsbad at 1:55 p.m

CLD – RNO

10:30 a.m. departure

Arrives in Reno at 12:00 noon
