# Badge Identification Requirements

TSA regulations require badge applicants to provide unexpired documents that establish both identity and employment authorization.\*

Below are examples of acceptable documents.

### **BADGE APPLICANTS MUST PRESENT:**

(1) one selection from List A

OR

a combination of (1) one selection from List B AME (1) one selection from List C




Documents that establish **Employment Authorization** 

Please bring one of the following:

U.S. Social Security card



Certified birth certificate



 Certification of report of birth issued by the Department of State, Forms DS-1350, FS-545 or FS-240





\*If you were born outside of the United States or the U.S. Territories:

You must provide (1) one of the following:

- Consular Report of Birth Abroad or Certification of Report of Birth; or
- U.S. Passport, Permanent Resident Card, or other List A document; or
- List B document, List C document, and your Alien Registration Number (A#)



## Badge Identification Requirements, Form I-9

TSA regulations require badge applicants to provide unexpired documents that establish both identity and employment authorization.\*

### **BADGE APPLICANTS MUST PRESENT:**

OR

(1) one selection from List A

#### LIST A

Documents that establish both Identity & Employment Authorization

#### Please bring one of the following:

- 1. U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport card
- 2. Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)
- 3. Foreign Passport that contains a temporary I-551 stamp or temporary I-551 printed notation on a machine readable immigrant visa
- 4. Employment Authorization Document that contains a photograph (Form I-766)
- 5. For a non-immigrant alien authorized to work for a specific employer because of their status:
  - a. Foreign Passport; and
  - b. Form I-94 or Form I-94a that has the following:
- (1) The same name as the passport;

and

- (2) An endorsement of the alien's non-immigrant status as long as that period of endorsement has not yet expired and the proposed employment is not in conflict with any restrictions or limitations identified on the form.
- 6. Passport from the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) or the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI) with Form I-94 or Form I-94a indicating non-immigrant admission under the Compact of Free Association between the United States and the FSM or RMI.

a combination of (1) one selection from List B AMI (1) one selection from List C

## Documents that establish **Identity**

#### Please bring one of the following:

- 1. Driver's license or ID card issued by a state or outlying possession of the U.S., provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
- 2. ID card issued by federal, state or local government agencies or entities, provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
- 3. School ID card with a photograph
- 4. Voter's registration card
- 5. U.S. Military card or draft record
- 6. Military dependent's ID card
- 7. U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
- 8. Native American tribal document
- 9. Driver's license issued by a Canadian government authority

For persons under age 18 who are unable to present a document above:

- 1. School record or report card
- 2. Clinic, doctor or hospital record
- 3. Daycare or nursery school record

## Documents that establish **Employment Authorization**

#### Please bring one of the following:

- 1. Social Security Card, unless the card includes one of the following restrictions:
  - (1) NOT VALID FOR EMPLOYMENT
  - (2) VALID FOR WORK ONLY WITH INS AUTHORIZATION
  - (3) VALID FOR WORK ONLY WITH DHS AUTHORIZATION
- 2. Certification of report of birth issued by the Department of State (Forms DS-1350, FS-545, FS-240)
- 3. Original or certified copy of birth certificate issued by a state, county, municipal authority, or territory of the U.S. bearing an official seal
- 4. Native American tribal document
- 5. U.S. Citizen ID Card (Form I-197)
- 6. Identification card for use of Resident Citizen in the United States (Form I-179)
- 7. Employment Authorization Document issued by the Department of Homeland Security

### \*If you were born outside of the United States or the U.S. Territories:

You must provide (1) one of the following:

- Consular Report of Birth Abroad or Certification of Report of Birth; or
- U.S. Passport, Permanent Resident Card, or other List A document; or
- List B document, List C document, and your Alien Registration Number (A#)
