The Reno-Tahoe Airport Authority (RTAA) Purchasing and Materials Management Division, in accordance with the provisions of NRS Chapter 338 is currently accepting sealed Invitation to Bid (ITBs) from qualified Contractors per NRS §338.1382 and licensed to work in the State of Nevada for the Taxiway Alpha and Aircraft Apron Reconstruction - Phase 4, and ancillary work associated with the Project, and to provide all material, labor, tools, expendable equipment, transportation services, permits and fees, utilities required, and all incidental items necessary to provide the scope of work entitled "Taxiway Alpha and Aircraft Apron Reconstruction."

A non-mandatory pre-Bid meeting will be held on March 7th, 2023, 3 PM [PST] at 4985 Texas Avenue, Reno, Nevada. A project site tour will follow immediately after the pre-Bid conference. The purpose of the meeting is to review and discuss the RTAA's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise policy, ITB Documents to include the contract drawings and specifications.

All sealed ITBs must be received at, and time stamped by the RTAA Purchasing and Materials Management Division, 2770 Vassar Street, Reno, Nevada 89502 on or before **2:00 PM [PST], March 22, 2023** at which time the sealed ITBs shall be opened.
